

A Retrospect of IAHA/AHA Region 14 Directors

The Arabian Horse Registry of America (AHRA) was founded in 1908 and the International Arabian Horse Association (IAHA) was formed in 1950.

In 1974, IAHA was re-organized from 10 regions to 18 regions encompassing the United States and Canada. In 2003, IAHA merged with the AHRA to form the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) and retained the same 18 regions, each with a director that is elected for a two (2) year term and can only serve two (2) consecutive terms.

Region 14 consists of the recognized AHA clubs in the following three (3) states: Kentucky, Ohio and West Virginia
