ENTRIES — Entries must be submitted on the Official Entry Form for the show. The entry form may be duplicated.

Farm names will be used only if the stable or farm is the owner appearing on the horse's registration papers.

Pre-entries must be paid in full when submitted and no open checks for pre-entries will be accepted. A photocopy of both sides of the Certificate of Registration of each horse entered must be submitted with the entry forms. For open classes, if the owner shown on the registration papers is different from the person entering the horse, an affidavit, a copy of the sales contract or authorization form must be filed with the Show Office. Any corporation owning and showing a horse must be a member of AHA and that membership number must be on the entry form.

ARRIVAL

- ► ARRIVE AFTER 10 A.M. WEDNESDAY, MAY 14
 Anyone arriving BEFORE will be considered early arrival and be assessed \$30 per stall. If we are able to let you in any earlier we will let you know. Early arrival Monday and Tuesday will be \$60 per stall.
- ► ABSOLUTELY NO ONE MAY ARRIVE EARLY WITHOUT CONTACTING SHOW MANAGEMENT
- ▶ EARLY ARRIVALS will be assessed \$30 per day (or any part there of) per stall fee for all arrivals before 10 a.m. on Wednesday, May 14 (if we are able to let you in any earlier we will let you know. Early arrival Monday and Tuesday will be \$60 per stall) or departure at 7 a.m. on Sunday, May 18 or you will be charged \$60 per horse, per stall, per hour. These fees will be added to your bill. EARLY ARRIVALS INCLUDE STALL SET-UP AND DECORATION CREWS.
- ▶ **DO NOT ARRIVE** earlier than indicated or we may not be able to stable your horse.

PAYMENT OF FEES

- Pre-entries must be paid in full when submitted and no open checks for pre-entries will be accepted. All checks will be deposited upon receipt.
- ► Full payment must accompany stall reservations to guarantee availability.
- Sponsorship and advertising fees must be paid before show begins.
- ► Farms running show tabs for additional expenses must provide a blank signed check or credit card form. You must settle these accounts with the show secretary before the end of the show. If your account is not settled before the end of the show, your check or credit card will be processed for the total amount due plus a \$100 penalty and a statement will be mailed after the show.
- MasterCard and VISA accepted with card imprint and/or signature or letter of authorization from the card holder. There will be a processing fee for credit cards.

GENERAL INFORMATION

RULES — This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the Rules of the USEF. Every class offered herein which is covered by the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Each participant in this show is responsible for a knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. Questions not covered by USEF Rules shall be decided by the Show Committee and its decisions will be final.

EXCESSIVE USE OF THE WHIP ON ANY HORSE IN A STALL, RUNWAY, SCHOOLING AREA, SHOW RING, OR ELSEWHERE ON THE COMPETITION GROUNDS BEFORE OR DURING A SHOW, BY ANY PERSON, CONSTITUTES A VIOLATION AND RENDERS THE OFFENDER SUBJECT TO PENALTY. JUDGES WILL BE EXPECTED TO ENFORCE THIS IN THE ARENA.

RESPONSIBILITY - All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Buckeye Arabian and Half-Arabian Alliance will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Buckeye Arabian and Half-Arabian Alliance against any and all loss damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs; including attorney fees which may be incurred as a result thereof. Exhibitors, grooms, handlers, owners, etc. are hereby warned that they may not use any device or conduct which may cause harm to any other person(s), horses, or equipment. THE SUBMITTING OF ANY ENTRY FORM TO THE SECRETARY SHALL CONSTITUTE AN ACCEPTANCE BY EACH PERSON SIGNING SAME OF THE PROVISIONS HEREIN SET FORTH.

PROTEST — A protest must be filed as set forth in USEF, Rule GR 602

JUDGES — In the event that due to an illness or failure of a judge to attend the show or to perform their duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Premium List, according to the USEF Rules (GR 1213).

No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee, steward or technical delegate who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place. No exhibitor has the right to inspect the judge's cards without the judge's permission.

AMATEUR STATUS — Every rider having reached their 19th birthday by December 1 must possess a current USEF Amateur card. Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification, Amateur cards are no longer available for nonmembers. Amateurs who do not have a current valid USEF cards on file in the show office prior to their class will be assessed a \$100 fine and will be disqualified from the class. Amateur Owner Classes a. Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by AR110.4.d.e.f. Horses registered in a farm/ranch/syndicate/

partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity as defined by AR110.4.d.e.f. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted in Owner classes.) b. Every competitor must be an amateur and the owner, or an amateur member of the owner's family (exception: substitute rider in AAOTR/AOTR/JOTR Working Hunter classes, refer to AR165.3). c. Owners' classes may be restricted to riders, drivers or handlers who are no longer eligible to compete as a junior exhibitor. d. For ownership by the same family, the term family includes the following: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, stepchild, brother, sister, half brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, step-brother and sister, grandparents and grandchildren, and in-laws of the same relation as stated above, e. Combined ownership is permitted in Owner's or Amateur Owner's classes. As per GR142.4 combined ownership is permitted in Junior Owner's or Amateur Owner's classes under the following conditions: 1. Two distinct non family owners may co-own a horse and show that horse in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes except that no family member of a professional may enter into this relationship. 'Non family owners' are defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family as defined by the Federation or Equestrian Canada. 2. A Horse that is co-owned by the two distinct non family owners must be registered with Arabian Horse Registry of America, Half Arabian Horse Registry, Anglo Arabian Horse Registry, Canadian Arabian Horse Registry or Canadian Partbred Arabian Registry, or other registry approved by the Arabian Horse Association as an "and" ownership relationship. An "or" ownership relationship does not enable two distinct non family owners to show in Junior Owner's or Amateur Owner's classes. 3. The right to show horses in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes when there are two distinct non family owners registered as the owners of said horse, does not extend to the family of these distinct non family owners. 4. In order to show in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes both distinct non family owners must be members of the Federation or Equestrian Canada and hold valid amateur cards or be juniors or a combination of amateur and junior. 5. Both distinct non family owners must be individuals, no Farm or Corporation co-owned horses are eligible. 6. No family member of a distinct non family owner may receive any remuneration in relation to the coowned horse as defined in SUBCHAPTER 13-B AMATEURS AND PROFESSIONALS (or Equestrian Canada equivalent). 7. Horses co-owned by more than two distinct non family owners cannot be shown in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes. 8. If the co-ownership relationship is terminated, that horse is not eligible to be co-owned by another distinct non family person for the remainder of that show year as defined by the Federation. The © USEF 2022 AR - 19 remaining owner and his or her family members are eligible to show in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes. 9. A horse that is co-owned by the two distinct non family members cannot be shown in a Maturity and Jackpot classes at any AHA National Championship show. 10. An individual AHA Affiliate Association/club may elect to not allow horses that are co-owned by two distinct non family member to compete in classes designated for Amateur Owner and Junior Owner for which they offer prize money, Futurity, or other restricted classes with payouts greater than \$2,500. 11. An individual member may only enter into two distinct co-owner relationships and compete with these arrangements in Junior Owner and Amateur Owner classes at Federation/EC approved shows. Arrangements with other individuals, same or otherwise, for purposes other than competing in Federation/EC approved show in Junior Owner and Amateur Owner classes, are not impacted. f. Leased horses are not eligible. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted in Owner Classes.)

LEVELING DIVISION — When Leveling classes are offered a rider may enter their appropriate level or opt to enter a higher level instead. This show will allow exhibitors to enter their appropriate achievement level or any higher level(s), all appropriate qualifications would be required, if applicable. Riders who are deemed Choice by their leveling points may not level down to Select. In addition, Elite riders may not level down to Choice or Select. In Working Western Classes where levels are run concurrently, a show may elect to allow riders to enter up (not down) in all levels in which appropriate qualifications and entry fees are applied in any circumstance. It is the rider's responsibility to enter the correct level and must submit their AHA leveling records with their entry form. JUNIOR — An individual who has not reached his or her 19th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. The age of an individual on December 1st will be maintained throughout the entire competition (See USEF Rule Book). JUNIOR HORSE - Junior horses are 5 years old or younger

FOOD BEVERAGE SERVICE — Contact Cindy Clinton for information on food and beverages for parties while on the grounds.

CALL FOR CLASSES — Classes will be called promptly at the times announced. First call occurs when horses two classes ahead enter the ring. Second call occurs when the preceding class enters the ring. Third call will be made while ribbons are being awarded in the preceding class. To prevent delays, the two-minute rule after the first horse is entered in the ring will be enforced. We appreciate your cooperation and request that the paddock managers be notified of any expected delays for tack changes. All delays must be approved by the Show Committee.

ADMISSION TO THE RING — No person will be allowed in the ring except participants in the class, judges, assistants, and show photographer. Attendants will be allowed in the ring only after being called by the judge, ringmaster, or announcer. We request that all attendants be properly attired.

CANCELLATION OR DIVISION OF CLASSES — The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide any classes or make any scheduling changes necessary for betterment of the Show. All such changes will be announced. Show Committee has the right to split all classes, and divide driving classes at their discretion.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES — Horses must have been entered, shown, and judged in the appropriate qualifying classes as specified in the prize list in order to be eligible to show in the Championships. Only first place horses from appropriate classes will compete in Supreme Champinship classes.

Should the highest scored horse eligible to compete for the Supreme Championship elect not to compete for Championship, no other horse may be substituted.

STALLIONS — Stallions may be shown in any performance class except Walk-Trot and Lead-Line.

PARTIES AND PRESENTATIONS — Anyone wishing to schedule or announce a party or any person requesting a special presentation in the ring must apply to the Show Committee. No presentations or announcements will be made without the permission of the Show Committee. Call Cindy Clinton at 937-937-1753 or email: Cindy@CindyClinton.com.

BAD CHECKS — There will be a \$100.00 charge for all checks that are refunded for insufficient funds.

REFUNDS — No refunds for any reason.

This show is approved by USEF, AHA & NSHR.

DOGS — All dogs must be kept on a leash.

EQUITATION AND SHOWMANSHIP DIVISION — Unless stated otherwise, open to Arabian stallions, mares and geldings and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian mares and geldings. Stallions are not permitted in Showmanship In Hand, Walk/Trot or Leadline.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION — Stabling is available on Wednesday, May 14, 2025 at 10 a.m. All horses must vacate the Fairgrounds by 7 a.m. Sunday, May 18. Anyone wishing to arrive early or stay later must make prior arrangements with the Show Manager (see page 11).

CAMPING — Camping Sites: The World Equestrian Center has 36 camping sites equipped with electric, water, and sewer and 60 with water and electricity for \$350 full hookup, \$275 for partial hookup. You must reserve these on your entry form and stall/camping reservation form. Check in with Cindy Clinton at 937-935-1753 prior to parking your RV. Reserve early. Reservation form on page 10.

PARKING — All horse vans and trailers must park across the street and campers must be parked in designated areas. Electricity and sewage disposal will be available.

UNLOADING — All horses must be unloaded in designated areas only.

STABLING AVAILABILITY — All stabling will be available on Wednesday, May 14, 2025 at 10 a.m. (after first come basis and after placement of sponsors) with no initial bedding furnished. Bedding, as well as feed and hay, will be available at at competitive prices. All horses entered must have a stall. For

"Preferred Stabling" see page 16. No stabling will be reserved without full payment. Stalls are available on a first come basis. There will be no refunds for stalls. Health certificates within 30 days and negative coggins required for all out of state horses. ALL HORSES MUST BE OUT BY 7 A.M. ON SUNDAY OR PAY A \$50 PER STALL FEE.

Mats removed from the stalls and not replaced will be billed \$50 per stall. Missing mats at end of the show will be billed \$40 per mat.

TACK STALLS — Majority of stalls are 12x12. There will be no removal of the doors or fronts for decorations. Tack stall decorations will be limited to hanging curtains on the fronts of the stalls only. No nails or staples are allowed. No stall roof is allowed to be covered with any type of material. **See fire marshall statement below.**

WORK AREAS — R & L will be designated for working and lunging horses. No lunging in the show arena or Bradley.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES — Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hoverboards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. Call Home Away From Home, 937-382-0985 to rent a golf cart.

VETERINARIAN — A veterinarian is on the grounds from 8 a.m. until the close of the show and on call 24 hours.

COGGINS AND CURRENT HEALTH PAPERS — Coggins and current health papers are required as per each state requirement. In addition beginning December 1, 2015, all horses entering the grounds of a Federation-licensed competition must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables.

FIRE MARSHALS REGULATIONS — All aisles will be open at all times. There will be no closing off of aisles for any reason. Decorations cannot exceed out more than 18 inches into main aisles. No stall roof is allowed to be covered with any type of material. Don't forget smoke alarms and fire extinguishers. No household electrical cords.

ROTATING AND CHALLENGE TROPHIES — Rotating or Challenge trophies will remain in the custody of the Buckeye Sweepstakes Committee.

SHARPS CONTAINERS — Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Competition management will place a notice of this requirement either in its prize list or on a specific handout given to trainers on check in at the competition. If local law has different requirements, local law will prevail. GR1210.4.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in **Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes**

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org

THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHAREGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

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Do I have to place in a class to be qualified for a Regional Championship Show?

No, you just need to participate.

What do you mean by "participate"?

Participation definition:

- a. In a class where horses compete together, participated means a horse/rider/driver/handler must have been entered, shown, and judged (perform at all required gaits both ways of the ring and remain in the ring until the class is completed and excused).
- b. In a class where horses compete individually, participated means a horse/rider must have completed the individual requirements of the class and be eligible to receive a score.
- c. Horses which are excused/disqualified/eliminated/received a "no score" are not considered "adjudicated" and would not receive credit for participation. A "zero score" is considered a score and receives a participation.

What is the qualification period for this year's Regionals and Nationals?

The qualification period is composed of:

- The current year up to the close of entries.
- The previous 14 months (past year of 2022 plus November and December of 2021).

You will also be able to use Top Five placings earned at Regionals, East Coast and Pacific Slope and Top Six placings earned at Eastern and Western Canadian Breeders for Nationals.

Does the participation have to be within the regional boundaries for the Regional Championship I want to attend?

No, you no longer need to qualify within that region. In the past this was true, if you wanted to attend the Region 14 Championship, you had to qualify at a Region 14 qualifying show. Now you can qualify within the Region 14 boundaries and go to any Regional Championship Show you want, it can be Region 14, or Region 13, or any other Regional you wish to attend.

Can I use a Regional Participation or a Regional Top Five to compete at another Regional Championship Show?

No, a Regional Participation or Regional Top Five can ONLY be used toward a National level qualification.

I would like to attend more than one Regional Championship Show, how can I do that?

This depends on the class you are competing in. If you are competing in a category I class, you would need a second participation to go to another Regional Championship Show. In fact, after obtaining a second participation, you are qualified to attend as many Regional Championships as possible that you wish to attend.

Where do I find the list of the categories?

This can be found in chapter 14 of the 2023 AHA Handbook or click https://www.arabianhorses.org/export/content.export/aha-docs/AHA Approved Qualifications.pdf

How do I qualify my horse for an Equitation or Showmanship class?

Remember, it is not the horse that needs to qualify, it is the rider or handler that needs to qualify through participation. See the link for the Equitation flow chart.

Is there a time in which it is important to place in a class?

At the Regional level, a Top Five placing will automatically qualify you for Nationals in that section.

What do you mean by "section"?

- A section is defined by the classes within that discipline and/or breed. An example is the Arabian Western Pleasure section. This section is made up of Open, AAO, AO, JO. AAT, AT, JT, Jr. Horse, Select, Choice, Elite, Primetime, Ladies/Gents, Maiden, Novice, Limit.
- For Dressage/Western Dressage classes, each level is considered its own section, i.e., Training is a section, First Level is a section, Second Level is a section, etc. You cannot use a participation in a First Level class to qualify for a class in Second Level.

How do I qualify for multiple classes at a Regional Championship Show?

Participation in one recognized class in that section now qualifies you to compete in as many classes within that section at any one Regional Championship Show of your choice.

Example: Participate at a qualifying show in HA/AA Western Pleasure ATR qualifies for any and as many classes in HA/AA Western Pleasure if you meet the definition for an Amateur, Amateur Owner, Leveling, Jr. Horse, etc.

How do I qualify for the East Coast, Pacific Slope, Eastern and Western Canadian Breeders Championship Shows?

These shows maintain their grandfather clause and continue to have their own requirements for their championship shows. Qualifications can be found in their respective prize lists. All four shows continue to maintain Regional status in that a Top Five earned at East Coast or Pacific Slope and a Top Six earned at Eastern or Western Canadian Breeders can be used to qualify for Nationals. If you do not place in either the Top Five or Top Six, the placing can be used as one of the participations needed for Nationals (refer to the category for number of participations needed).

Can I use qualifications earned in the Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Western Pleasure section for my Arabian Western Pleasure horse?

No, as qualifications are earned by the horse. A Half-Arabian cannot earn qualifications for a purebred Arabian and vice-a-verse.

Where can I find a list of the sections?

Can my trainer qualify my horse for me for an Amateur class?

A Professional cannot qualify the horse for an Amateur (via participation, Top Fives or Top Sixes, National Championships or National Reserve Championships), but an Amateur can qualify the horse for a Professional. If the Amateur obtains a participation in a Western Pleasure ATR, the trainer can use that qualification for the Open Western Pleasure.

I am unable to attend the qualifying shows, how can I get my horse qualified for an Owner class for Regionals and Nationals?

In the past, an "Owner" would be required to qualify the horse for an "Owner" class at the Regional and National level. This has now changed, any "Amateur" can now qualify the horse and the "Owner" can use that qualification at the Regional and National level. For the definition of who can compete in an "Owner" class refer to USEF rules under AR110 (this reference defines owner, not how they qualify to compete).

We do not have competitions in my area that offer classes for me to qualify, what can I do?

We are continuing with Open Show qualifications for most of the specialty classes. These require participation and the rules at found in Chapter 15 of the 2023 AHA Handbook.

If the class you need does not require specialized equipment, course, judges and/or cattle, consider purchasing a TBA slot for your class. An example might be a Park, Native Costume or Ladies Side Saddle class.

How do I qualify for Nationals?

A Regional Top Five obtained in your section is the easiest way. A Top Five earned Arabian Hunter Pleasure ATR qualifies for any and as many classes in Arabian Hunter Pleasure if you meet the definition for an Amateur, Amateur Owner, Leveling, Jr. Horse, etc.

I did not receive a Top Five at a Regional Championship; can I still get qualified for Nationals?

Yes, depending on the category, you will need either 2 or 3 participations. One of these participations can be from a Regional Championship, meaning, you did not place in the Top Five but can still use that "Regional" participation to go to Nationals.

Can I use the same participation qualifications or Regional Top Five (Top Five from East Coast, Pacific Slope or Top Six from Western and Eastern Canadian Breeders) for multiple National Shows?

Yes, qualifications are **not used up** during the qualification period. If you go to Youth/Mid-Summer Nationals on a qualification for that section, you can use those same qualifications for Canadian, Sport Horse and U.S. Nationals as long as those classes are offered for the section you qualified in. The same rules apply in that you must be the owner to ride in an owner class (or meet the family or co-owner definition in the USEF rules), have a Junior horse to compete in the Junior Horse class, etc.

Can I use a National Participation or a National placing to compete at another Regional or National Championship Show?

Beginning in the year 2020, AHA Recognized National Champions are qualified for two additional years and may re-enter **that National Championship class**. Reserve National Champions are qualified for an

additional year to re-enter **that National Championship class**. Previous 2019 and earlier AHA Recognized National Champions are qualified for life and may re-enter that National Championship class. Previous Lifetime qualifications earned may be used at any National Championship Show (if the class is offered). Currently a National qualification earned at any AHA National Championship can be used at any other AHA National Championship if **that class** is offered at that AHA National Championship show. A Top Ten placing (excludes Champion and Reserve) does not qualify the horse for future National Shows. See QUAL 113 for complete rules.

A National placing cannot be used as a qualification for any Regional Championship Shows.

Do National Champions and Reserve National Champions from Mid-Summer Nationals fall into the above rule?

Yes, Mid-Summer is a National Show and horses, and Equitation Riders can take advantage of the rule.

Are there any classes which do not require qualifications?

Yes, these are classes which are "specialized" and are not (or rarely) held either at Arabian and/or Open shows. They fall into category IV.

Do I need to qualify for the 2-Year-Old Sport Horse In-Hand class at Regionals and Nationals?

Yes, you will need to qualify under Category II which requires participation at a qualifying show to compete at any and as many Regional Championships. The National qualification needed is a Regional Top Five or better or participate in two qualifying AHA Approved shows (one can be a participation from a regional if you do not place in the Top Five).

How do I qualify for Performance Halter?

You must compete in a Performance class (Riding or Driving) at that show in order to compete in the Performance Halter class at that same show. This is the requirement for local qualifying, Regional and National Championships. See REQ 112.3 for complete rule.

How do I qualify for Ranch Horse Conformation?

This rule is similar to Performance Halter. The difference is that you must be entered, shown, and judged in at least one riding class in the Ranch division at the show. See USEF AR229.2 for complete rule.

Can I use participation in prize money classes to qualify for Regionals or Nationals?

Classes that are deemed program classes (pay to play) are not eligible to be used for qualifications. These would be classes such as restricted Sweepstakes classes (Sweepstakes only horses competing), Spotlight Futurity, Medallion, AEPA, AWPA, local Jackpot, etc. Sweepstakes designated classes can be used for participation as those classes are open to Sweepstakes and non-Sweepstakes horses.







For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves inherent risks and dangers. 
